Our Story:

The Ecclesbourne Valley Railway runs from Duffield on the Midland Main Line to the market town of Wirksworth. It was opened in 1867 by the Midland Railway. Passenger services ended in 1947 but freight traffic continued until 1989. In its final years the major traffic was limestone from the Wirksworth quarries, however, its proximity to the railway centre at Derby meant that the line was used to test their new products. Most of the first-generation Derby built Diesel Multiple Units (DMUs) were trialled on our line including the Midland Pullman, a luxury DMU, which it has been suggested was the forerunner of the High Speed Train.

After closure in 1989, the track returned to nature but in 2000, a group of enthusiasts started the Herculean task of reviving the line. Just over 10 years later in April 2011, HRH the Duke of Gloucester officially re-opened the line after arriving from Duffield by steam train.

The track is the responsibility of WyvernRail but almost all of the restoration work, maintenance and operational roles are done by volunteers from the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway Association (EVRA) which is a charitable company limited by guarantee.

In addition to the work of restoring the line for passenger traffic, **EVRA** is active in providing information for visitors and the restoration work of rolling stock and locomotives that are used on the line. We also maintain a museum of items and information relevant to the line and its association with the surrounding area. Our volunteers form part of the Permanent Way team who look after the track.

Since 2001 **EVRA** have received a number of grants, legacies and donations that have helped finance some of our work including an Information Centre, Museum Coach, the rebuilding of platforms 1 and 3, and the provision of a platform at Ravenstor which enabled the re-opening of the incline from 2005.

A Heritage Lottery Grant enabled the restoration of the former Ferrybridge No. 3 Barclay 0-4-0 steam engine in 2007 and the engine returned to steam on 2010. Our 2nd Barclay has also been returned to steam whilst our 0-6-0 Hudswell-Clarke loco is well under way to running again. Five BR Mk1 coaches have been restored and are in service.

A 2ft. gauge line is in service with a Lister powered locomotive and man-rider and this runs on certain days through the year.
